**2001** – Anthrax Attacks, Public Health Emergency Preparedness, Electronic Disease Surveillance Begins

**2002** – Largest Outbreak of West Nile Disease in US, Surgeon General Reports Alarming Increase in Childhood Obesity

**2003** – 1-mill Levy Passes (Messages: Mosquito Control, Medical Services, Immunizations, Food Safety, Senior Health), Smallpox Vaccinations of Some Public Health Employees, New Emerging Diseases such as SARS, Monkeypox and Mad Cow Disease

**2004** – Flu Vaccine Shortage, New Health Commissioner

**2005** – Avian (Bird) Flu, Hurricane Katrina

**2006** – Legionella Disease, Medication Assistance, Smoke Free Ohio Passes, First Mass Flu Clinic Exercise

**2007** – Electronic Death Registration, Smoking Investigations, School Surveillance, School Inspections, Medical Services Move to MVHC, Other Services Remain at ZMCHD

**2008** – MVHC Opens, 0.5 mill Levy Passes (Messages: Immunizations, Food Safety, Disease Monitoring), Lead RRC Grant, Travel Immunizations, Dental Clinic Expands, Renovation, Community Health Planning

**2009** – H1N1 Flu Pandemic, Pertussis Outbreak

**2010** – Bedbugs, County Health Rankings, Lead Assessments, Tdap Immunizations, Cutbacks

**2013** – 1-mill Levy
