

SEWAGE TREATMENT SYSTEMS PERMIT APPLICATION



SYSTEM DESIGN

Contact a registered a sewage installer to design your sewage treatment system and complete a layout plan.



PLUMBING PERMIT

Apply for a plumbing permit. If not building immediately, you can still apply for a permit and pay the initial \$50.00 application fee.



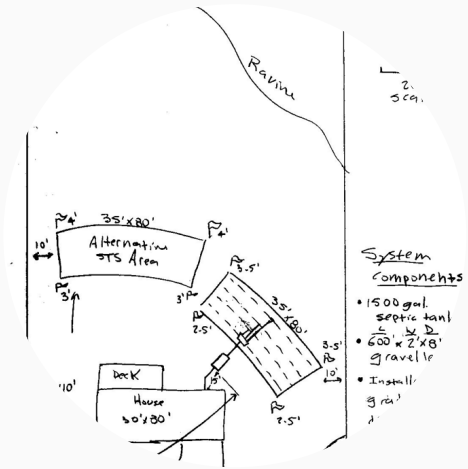
INSPECTION & APPROVAL

The registered installer must call the health department before covering the system for an inspection. Installer must also provide an "as-built" record at the time of inspection.



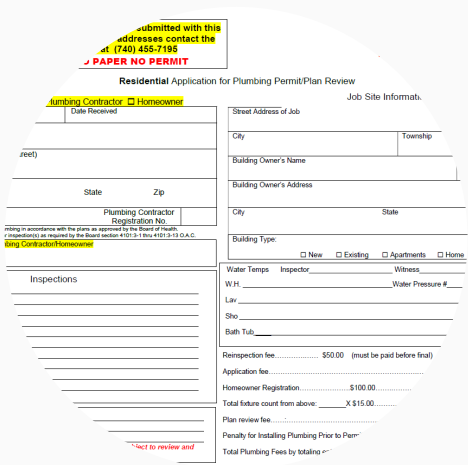
SITE & SOIL EVALUATION

Contact a certified soil scientist that will provide you with a site and soil evaluation for your property.



APPLICATION FOR SITE REVIEW & PERMIT

Complete and submit the application for site review and permit (which **includes a fee**) along with the site and soil evaluation and the system design.



SITE REVIEW

Sanitarian will conduct a site review. When approved, our office will notify the contractor or homeowner that the system installation may begin.



12 MONTH INSPECTION

A sanitarian will inspect a sewage treatment system no later than 12 months after its installation to ensure the system is operating properly.
